Rotary History:

One of the most widely printed and quoted statements of ethics in the world was created by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor in 1932 when he was asked to take charge of Chicago based company facing bankruptcy. Taylor looked for a way to save the struggling company mired in financial difficulties. He drew up a code of ethics for all employees to follow in their business and professional lives. The 4-Way Test became the guide for sales, production, advertising and all relations with dealers and customers, and the survival of the company was credited to this simple philosophy.
