6 WILD POLIO (WPV1) CASES REPORTED LAST WEEK, ALL FROM PAKISTAN. THIS BRINGS US TO 78 CASES YEAR TO DATE (23 IN AFGHANISTAN AND 55 IN PAKISTAN). THERE WERE ALSO 24 POSITIVE ENVIRONMENTAL SAMPLES (ES), AGAIN ALL FROM PAKISTAN. BUT SOME RELATIVELY GOOD NEWS...IT HAS NOW BEEN 11 WEEKS SINCE THE LAST CASE OCCURRED IN AFGHANISTAN. Dates of The most recent wild poliovirus cases (WPV1):

Afghanistan: 9/14/24 Pakistan: 11/06/24

In our other battlefront against polio NO NEW CASES of the circulating variant poliovirus, (cVDPV2), were reported. There were however, 2 new Positive Environmental Samples (ES).
